Commercial and Industrial Distribution Boxes

Commercial or industrial buildings often require three-phase power and more complex distribution boards. These can accommodate 12 to 36 circuits or more, depending on the electrical load and equipment requirements . Circuits are grouped by load type, such as lighting, HVAC, machinery, and office equipment. Safety features may include RCBOs (Residual Current Breakers with Overcurrent Protection), surge protection devices, and arc fault detection devices for enhanced protection
