TIA standards are widely used in North America for structured cabling, data centers, and industrial networks . **Telcordia Standards:** Telcordia GR-20 focuses on reliability, durability, and environmental performance, often required by telecom operators in North America. It emphasizes long-term performance under harsh conditions, including outdoor and aerial installations . **ISO/IEC Standards:** ISO/IEC 11801 defines...
