Access switches are network devices that connect end-user devices to the network, enabling data transmission and communication within subnets and enterprise networks.

Overview of Access Switches

Access switches operate at the access layer of a hierarchical network, directly interfacing with end-user devices such as computers, IP phones, printers, and IoT devices . They serve as the primary point of network entry for users and are responsible for routing and switching data packets from the distribution layer to connected devices . Unlike core or distribution switches, access switches typically have high port density to accommodate numerous devices and provide connectivity within subnets .

Key Features

- Layer Functionality: Access switches can operate at Layer 2 (L2) for basic switching or Layer 3 (L3) for routing between subnets .
- Port Density and Speed: They offer multiple ports, commonly supporting 10/100/1000 Mbps Ethernet, allowing high-speed data transmission to end devices .
- Power over Ethernet (PoE): Many access switches provide PoE to power devices like IP cameras, phones, and wireless access points over a single cable .
- Scalability and Management: Access switches can be managed or unmanaged, with managed switches offering VLAN segmentation, QoS, security features, and remote monitoring
