The main switch in a distribution box acts as the master control, allowing the entire electrical system to be turned on or off for safety and maintenance.

Main Switch

The main switch, also called the main breaker or incomer, controls the entire electrical supply entering the distribution box. It is typically located at the top of the panel for easy access and is rated for the maximum current capacity of the system . Flipping this switch disconnects all power to the building, which is essential during emergencies, maintenance, or troubleshooting . In some modern boards, the main switch may be combined with residual-current devices (RCDs) or RCBOs to provide both overcurrent and leakage protection .

Circuit Breakers

Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs) are automatic switches that protect individual circuits from overcurrent or short circuits. When excessive current flows, the MCB trips, interrupting the power flow. After resolving the issue, the breaker can be reset by switching it back on . These breakers are arranged in columns and connected to the busbars, distributing power to different circuits such as lighting, outlets, and appliances .
