Coordination with Other Devices

Setting the relay pickup at multiple times the rated current also allows proper coordination with upstream and downstream protective devices. For example, when coordinating with fuses, the relay's primary current setting is often around three times the fuse rating to ensure the relay acts as a backup rather than tripping before the fuse, maintaining selective isolation of faults . This coordination prevents unnecessary disconnection of healthy parts of the system and ensures only the faulted section is isolated
