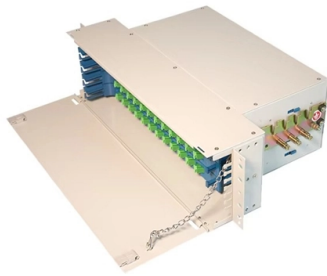


The switch has a light reception threshold

A switch's light reception threshold defines the minimum optical power level required for the SFP module to reliably detect incoming signals.

Understanding RX Thresholds

Optical transceivers in switches, such as SFPs, have receive (RX) power thresholds that determine when the incoming light signal is strong enough to be interpreted correctly. If the received signal falls below this threshold, the switch may trigger a warning or alarm, indicating potential signal loss or degradation . These thresholds are typically defined by the SFP manufacturer and are often hard-coded into the module, though some transceivers allow threshold adjustments via specialized equipment .

RX Power Levels

- Normal RX Power: The incoming light signal is within the SFP's operating range, ensuring reliable data transmission .
- Low RX Warning: The signal is approaching the minimum threshold, which may indicate dirty connectors, poor fiber quality, or long-distance attenuation .
- Low RX Alarm: The signal is below the threshold, and the switch may report a link failure or degraded performance . For example, a standard 10G LR SFP may have a low warning threshold around -14 dBm, meaning signals weaker than this could start to experience errors . Extremely low RX readings, such as -30 dBm or lower, usually...
