What "Normal" Means

- The transceiver module is recognized and operating within its specified parameters, including voltage, temperature, and laser output power .
- No alarms or warnings are triggered for temperature, voltage, or optical power thresholds .
- The interface statistics (input/output errors, drops, collisions) are within acceptable limits, indicating stable operation .

How to Verify Optical Port Status

- Check Interface Status: Use commands like `show interface status` to see if the port is up and running. Look for "up/up" in the status and protocol columns .
- Inspect Transceiver Details: Commands such as `show interfaces transceiver` or `show idprom interface` provide information about the SFP module type, serial number, and optical power levels .
- Monitor Optical Metrics: Ensure the input and output optical power are within the recommended range for the transceiver. Values outside the range may indicate fiber issues or misalignment
