

Two uplink ports of the optical splitter



AI Overview

Two uplink ports on an optical splitter provide redundancy and load-sharing for signals sent to the central network, enhancing reliability and network resilience.

Function of Uplink Ports

In a passive optical network (PON), an optical splitter divides a single optical signal from the central Optical Line Terminal (OLT) into multiple outputs for Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at end users' premises, reducing the need for dedicated fibers to each subscriber . Two uplink ports allow the splitter to connect to the network in a dual-path configuration, which can serve two main purposes:

- Redundancy: If one uplink fails, the second uplink maintains connectivity, ensuring uninterrupted service .
- Load Balancing: Optical signals can be distributed across both uplinks, improving bandwidth utilization and reducing the risk of congestion .

How It Works

- In the uplink direction, the optical splitter multiplexes signals from multiple downstream ONTs or remote optical modules into one or two uplink channels that connect to the OLT or core switch .
- Each uplink port can carry multiple wavelength channels, depending on the network design and the type of splitter (e.g., 2:8 passive optical splitting for two channels), .
- In some configurations, such as the RG-MUX-EXT module, the two uplink ports split optical power evenly (50:50) to two separate links, creating a dual-uplink network that enhances reliability between the core and access sides
