Outdoor self-supporting variants add a steel messenger wire, enabling aerial deployment without additional support, with spans up to 50 meters.

Fiber Type and Performance

Butterfly cables almost universally use bend-insensitive single-mode fibers, such as ITU-T G.657 types, which tolerate tight bend radii and maintain low signal loss. This makes them ideal for fiber-to-the-home (FTTH), data centers, and other high-bandwidth applications.
