A secondary distribution box is best configured with appropriately sized breakers, a clear layout for future expansion, and a system topology that balances reliability and cost, such as a secondary selective or spot network arrangement.

System Topology

For secondary distribution, the choice of system arrangement significantly affects reliability and service continuity:

- Simple Radial: Least expensive and simplest, suitable for low-density areas. It has a single source, so any failure in the transformer or feeder results in service loss. Easy to coordinate but limited reliability .
- Secondary Selective: Uses a loop of substations fed from two sources with open switches to isolate faults. This allows maintenance or cable failures without interrupting service to other substations, improving reliability .
- Spot Network: Ideal for high-reliability applications like commercial centers or high-rise buildings. Multiple transformers are paralleled on the secondary side through network protectors, ensuring continuous service even if one transformer fails .

Breaker and Load Configuration

- Circuit Breaker Sizing: Each breaker should match the load it protects. Use the 80% rule for continuous loads to prevent overheating and allow future expansion
