Its small 1.25 mm ferrule is half the size of the older SC connector's 2.5 mm ferrule, allowing twice the port density on network panels and transceivers .

In SFP modules, the LC connector serves as the physical interface between the transceiver and fiber optic cables, enabling precise alignment of the fiber core with the optical transmitter and receiver . This ensures efficient light coupling, low insertion loss, and reliable signal transmission. LC connectors are especially favored in data centers, enterprise LANs, SANs, and telecom networks due to their compact size and high-density capability .

- Compact duplex form: Two LC plugs can be clipped together for duplex connections, often with reversible polarity in uniboot designs .
- Secure latching: Positive click mechanism prevents accidental disconnection
