Adequate spacing prevents short circuits and enhances system safety: Bare copper busbars: Minimum clearance $\geq 20\text{mm}$ to avoid phase-to-phase or phase-to-ground faults. Insulated busbars: Insulation allows for reduced clearance but must meet IEC 60664 or UL 746C dielectric strength.
