Clearances: Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access (2026 NEC update). These systems, made from metal or plastic, are open structures designed to support electrical conductors, ensuring proper organization and safety. The use and installation of cable trays is covered by legally enforceable OSHA regulations in 29 CFR 1910. Cable trays should always be installed according to proper load capacity calculations and spacing.
