Overview

Fiber Termination Box, also known as FTB, typically consists of two main parts: the outer shell body and the adapter tray that protects the fiber connector points. It is a crucial component in fiber optic networks, primarily used for terminating, connecting, and managing fiber. I used the term "motor termination box". I found out however in that process, that there is no "official" term for it anywhere, even in NEMA MG1 specifications where they use both "terminal box" and "conduit box" interchangeably (never peckerhead or connection box however).
