- Electrical conductivity needs: Aluminum is chosen for its high conductivity and low weight, but the thickness is adjusted to meet grounding and fault current specifications.
- Fiber count and configuration: Cables with more optical fibers may require a larger central aluminum tube to accommodate the fibers, slightly increasing the aluminum proportion
