A three-level distribution system typically consists of:

- **First Level – Main Distribution Cabinet:** This is the primary entry point for power from the transformer. It uses Air Circuit Breakers (ACBs) with short-time delay functions to handle high short-circuit currents and protect the entire system. It ensures selective coordination with downstream devices and provides the first layer of protection against overloads and short circuits .
- **Second Level – Sub-Distribution Cabinet:** Positioned below the main cabinet, this level uses Molded-Case Circuit Breakers (MCCBs). MCCBs provide precise protection for motors, lighting, and general loads, coordinating with the main ACB to ensure only the faulty circuit is disconnected .
- **Third Level – Switch Box / Final Distribution:** This is the final junction box for individual appliances or equipment. It typically uses Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs) and Residual Current Devices (RCDs/RCBOs) for leakage protection. This level ensures that only the affected appliance or socket is disconnected during a fault, preventing hazards like electric shock and localized overloads
