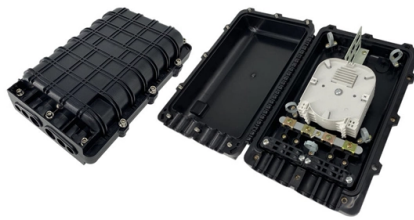

Many factors, like core mismatch and contamination, can increase splice loss.
