

Where should the two ends of the pigtail be connected

- Attach the Pigtail to the Device Connect the free end of the pigtail to the device terminal:
 - Hot (black) to brass screw
 - Neutral (white) to silver screw
 - Ground (bare or green) to the green screw If using screw terminals, bend the wire into a clockwise hook (J-hook) to ensure it tightens under the screw head .
- Organize and Secure Fold the wires neatly into the electrical box without straining the connections. Secure the device to the box and attach the faceplate
