The connection methods for SC, FC, ST, and FT connectors with optical fibers are basically the same. Due to slight structural differences, the LC connector uses a latch mechanism, the FC connector uses a threaded screw mechanism, the SC connector uses a push-pull with latch mechanism, and the ST.

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Before connecting an optical fiber, attach temporary labels to both ends of the optical fiber for identification. Remove protective caps from optical fiber connectors, insert optical fibers into the ...

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Align the module with the device's SFP port, ensuring TX/RX labels match the cable's direction. Gently push the module until it clicks into place (a latch will secure it).
