- **Modular Design:** These ports are empty until a compatible transceiver module is inserted. The module determines whether the connection is fiber optic (single-mode or multi-mode) or copper .
- **Labels and Symbols:** Switches often label optical ports with terms like “SFP,” “uplink,” or “fiber”. Some switches have combo ports, which can accept either an RJ45 Ethernet module or an optical module....
